Services we offer

- Support, advice and signpost parents
- Provide Thrive assessments and initiate Thrive interventions
- Offer advice and support on issues relating to behaviour management and inclusion
- Assist with interventions as a graduated response, liaising with staff about issues relating to pupils' well-being and behaviour including early intervention and assessment
- Help maintain equal opportunities and improve learning outcomes for pupils with behavioural difficulties
- Provide intervention that is monitored, reviewed and evaluated to ensure this continues to meet their needs
- Provide targeted support to assist with the successful reintegration of pupils back into education
- Working proactively with outside agencies to ensure the service provided is cohesive and effective
- Provide recommendations on bespoke timetabling, classroom design and layout
- Provide support and advice on Managing Extreme Behaviour including; handling aggression and violence, working with angry learners, passive aggression, ADHD, Autism, Aspergers and disaffected learners

The Referral Process

Who can be referred?

The Bridge Education Centre Outreach Service is for pupils who are at risk of exclusion or not engaging in their mainstream setting.

What we do:

- Set up an initial meeeting / conversation with school
- Set up meeting at school or home with the young person, school and parent as required
 - Agree a programme of support
- Provide outreach support in school or home
 - Monitor, review and evaluate progress
 - Give advice and suggest strategies following classroom observations
 - Work with staff providing support, adviceand training
- Work with individual pupils and small groups
- Provide 6-8 week intervention programmes

- Is based at The Bridge Education Centre
- Supports KS3 & KS4 students in our feeder schools
- Consists of trained and experienced staff who work flexibly according to the needs of the pupils and school
