MOCK EXAMS - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All pupils are expected to arrive between 08.45 – 09.00 (At the very latest 09.15)

Pupils will then settle in their exam room and go through the process of the exam and all the exam conditions they need to follow.

AM exams will start promptly at 09.30 but pupils need to be in the rooms at least 10 minutes before, going through the rules of the exam, which is a national requirement by JCQ. Once the length of the exam has finished pupils will be allowed to leave site and go home if there are no afternoon exams, or leave site and return for 12.00 in readiness for afternoon exams.,

PM exams will start between 12.00 – 12.30 as stated on the timetable and run for the length of the exam and then pupils will be allowed to leave and go home.

Should pupils travel to school via Hampshire transport (taxi) or (Keith School Mini Bus) then alternative arrangement needs to be made, EXAMPLE: If there is no exam in the AM pupils make own way into school but a Hampshire taxi or Keith school mini bus will be available to transport home after the PM exam. The same applies if there is no PM exam, pupils will be brought into school but will need to make alternative arrangements to get home after the AM exam.
